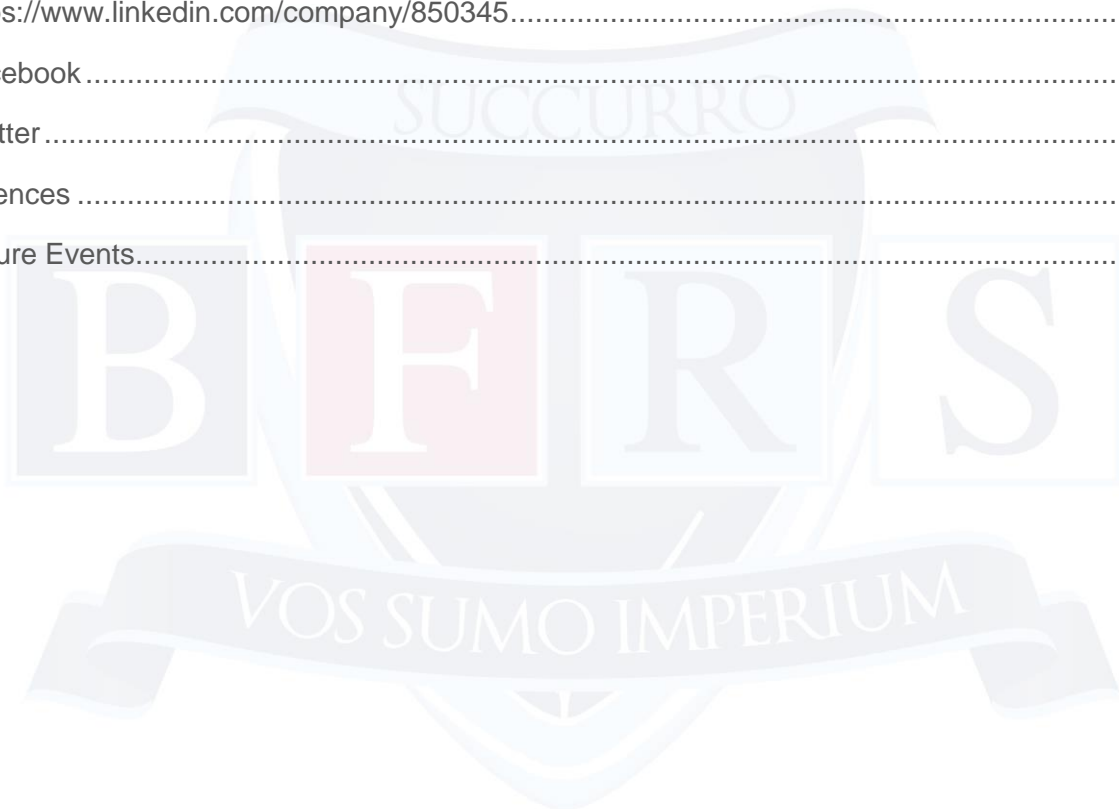

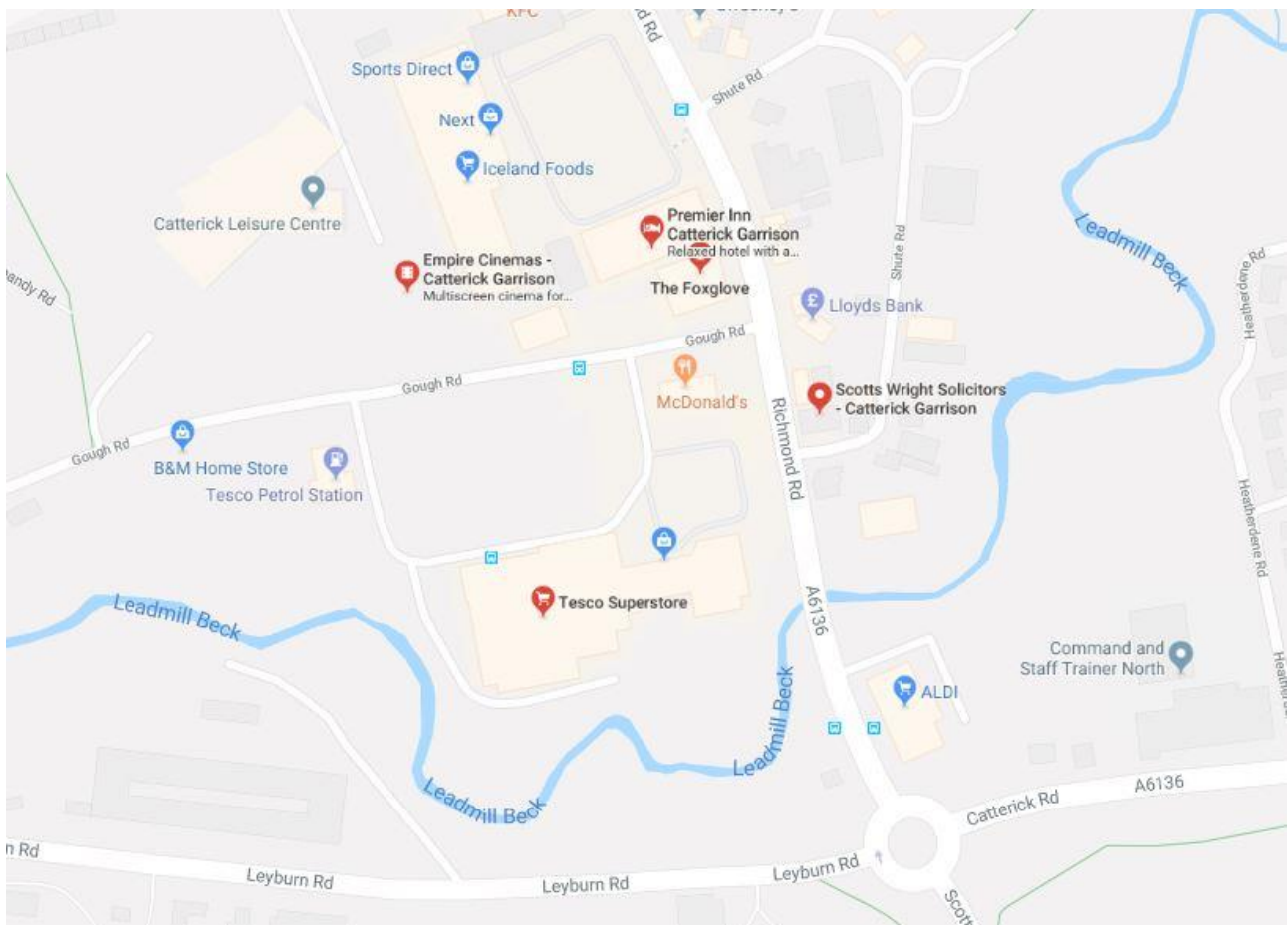

After travelling on the Catterick Road for 3.7 miles you will reach the centre of the Garrison, turning right at the roundabout onto A6136 follow this for approximately 400 metres, the turn left onto Gough Road, the Catterick Garrison Leisure Centre will be on your right opposite Tesco.

On the Day

- **Sign in at the BFRS Pre-Registered Reception** – On arrival please produce your Event Pass at the reception, either using a download on your phone or by a printed copy, also at the reception pick up a copy of the Event Guide.
- **New Challenge New Beginnings Magazine (NCNB)** – This has information on all the exhibitors, take the time to browse through the magazine whilst enjoying a brew in the networking area, and keep it on hand throughout the day. NCNB is a magazine produced by British Forces Resettlement Service. It is a lifestyle/ resettlement magazine for the Armed Forces Community. It will cover issues that are relevant to the Armed Forces Community (AFC), Serving Military personnel, Reservist, Service Leavers, Veterans and Families.
- **Check the Floor Plan** – This will show you the layout of the event to help you find the companies you're looking for. This is also available in your Event Guide.
- **Keep an open mind** – You may already know what companies you are wanting to approach, but also have a look at what the other exhibitors have to offer. There may be positions you would not expect.
- **Ask the right questions** – If you've done your research, you'll know the basics, like what positions a company may be employing for. This event gives you the ideal platform to discuss opportunities with employers from a wide range of sectors. Ask if they already employ from the Forces, if so what are their thoughts on the Military working within their companies, do the Military have the qualities they are looking for.
- **Notes** – Make notes, to help you ask the right questions.
- **CV's** – Bring plenty of CVs to pass onto those exhibiting, there will also be a CV drop box at the event reception.
- **Don't come alone** – Why not bring your colleagues, friends or family? The Event provides a great amount of information for those that may have only just started their transition, and in many cases, can assist the family members in finding employment.

Dressing for the event

You only get one first impression, so having the perfect outfit is the key to securing a job interview. If you look the part, employers will already be impressed, and will be more likely to see you as the right candidate for the job. The way you dress for a Career Fair says how precise, neat, and professional you really are.

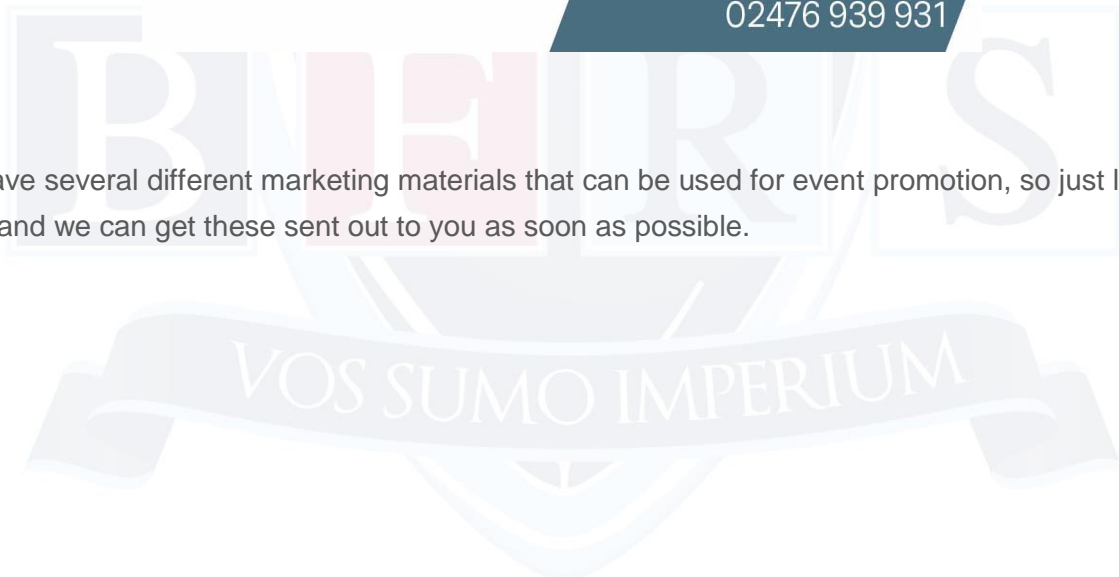
